BALLOT MEASURES

Welcome to the Oregon Family Council Voter's Guide Ballot Measure section. Here you'll find information on each of the four statewide measures and several local measures that may appear on your 2020 General Election ballot. We've also included an OFC recommendation on how to vote and a helpful commentary on each measure's strengths and weaknesses.

We hope this guide will be a valuable supplement to other information sources in deciding how to vote.

IT'S OKAY TO DISAGREE

Many of the ballot measures we are asked to vote on this year are very complex. We have done our best to provide sound reasoning for the positions we have taken.

And while we provide a recommendation on measures, the last thing we want is to imply that these positions are the only ones Christians should take. Differences are okay and to be expected—particularly when it comes to applying the principles of the Bible to complex public policy issues.

We implore you to be careful and prayerful about the use of this Voter's Guide, and we encourage you to utilize other information sources. Most importantly, we urge you to vote. Your vote makes a difference.

MEASURE 107

Amends Constitution: Allows limiting political campaign contributions and expenditures.

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

NO We recommend a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

This constitutional amendment would allow the Oregon Legislature to set limits on political campaign contributions and expenditures. This is a change from current constitutional protections which prohibit such limits based on free speech provisions. It would also require campaign ads to show who paid for them.

OFC COMMENTARY

In 1722, Benjamin Franklin wrote: "Whoever would overthrow the Liberty of a Nation must begin by subduing the Freedom of Speech." Measure 107 would "subdue" our freedom of political speech. The freedom of speech provisions of the Oregon Constitution explicitly prohibit laws restricting election spending. Our Constitution protects our right to speak freely on political matters, to spend our money to advance that speech, and to join with others in such advocacy. Measure 107 would limit these rights. One outcome of Measure 107 that concerns us is the empowerment of the rich. The US Supreme Court has ruled it is unconstitutional to limit the amount an individual can spend on one's own political campaign. By limiting spending on all others, it creates a huge advantage for rich candidates. Another concern is the measure's requirement of disclosure of who paid for what ads. Such knowledge can be useful, but today's "cancel culture" and bullying reprisals give us pause concerning this requirement. Finally, under Measure 107 all policy organizations—conservative and liberal alike—would lose much ability to educate voters or support candidates. As a result voters would be far less educated about candidates and issues at election time. We recommend a NO vote on Measure 107.

MEASURE 108

Increases Cigarette and Cigar Taxes.

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

LEAN NO We suggest a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

Measure 108 increases cigarette taxes by two dollars a pack. It also establishes taxes on e-cigs and vaping devices which are used by some to wean off more harmful cigarettes. These increased tax dollars will be used to grow the Oregon Health Authority's budget and expand the state's footprint in the health care system.

OFC COMMENTARY:

While we acknowledge the detrimental effects smoking has on health, and therefore the state's health cost for those using the state plan, it seems Measure 108's intention is not to reduce smoking. The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has demonstrated an insatiable appetite for money. Adding exorbitant taxes to those who smoke is simply another step in this direction. But increasing taxes in a time of pandemic and deep recession is incredibly short sighted. Worse yet, since many smokers tend to be lower on the income scale, this massive tax increase (\$2 per pack) is being levied on those most unable to pay it. Furthermore, tobacco taxes are a foolish funding source. America has had a lot of experience with tobacco taxes and the data is clear: revenue goes up for a short time but then recedes to levels lower than before the new tax was added. If 108 passes, the new OHA budget will remain, yet we'll have one more budget hole to be plugged with more and more taxes. Finally, the OHA, which is plagued with incompetence and scandal, promotes many highly controversial procedures such as free abortions for illegals, mandatory in-home visits of all newborns, sex change operations, and puberty blocking drugs for confused children. For these reasons we lean toward a NO vote on Measure 108.

MEASURE 109

Oregon Psilocybin Services Act.

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

NO We recommend a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

Measure 109 would allow the manufacture and distribution of the hallucinogenic drug psilocybin, more commonly known as "magic mushrooms". Psilocybin is currently being tested by the FDA to treat Major Depressive Disorder. Measure 109 would expand use far beyond this one disorder and does not require any medical background for those who dispense it.

OFC COMMENTARY

The FDA recently gave "breakthrough therapy" status to the drug psilocybin to be studied for a single condition: Major Depressive Disorder. This means that the FDA is now engaged in research to learn both the efficacy and safety of the drug for this one limited condition. Measure 109 wants to leapfrog over the normal safety standards and allow the general distribution of this powerful hallucinogen for use for a wide variety of conditions. Furthermore, Measure 109 does not require any medical background for those who dispense the drug. Clearly, this is a bad idea. Decisions of this magnitude properly belong to our Legislature. This is the setting where controversial new ideas can be properly vetted through committee hearings, with testimony from medical community, law enforcement, and other experts. Leapfrogging both the FDA's ongoing studies and the Legislature for thoughtful implementation is beyond foolish and may cross the line to dangerous. We are warned by large numbers of doctors, including the Oregon Psychiatric Physicians Association (OPPA) that a likely outcome of this approach would be severe mental health issues. The OPPA also raises the concern that this powerful drug will become available to minors. We urge a NO vote on Measure 109.

MEASURE 110

Drug Addiction Treatment and Recovery Act.

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

NO We recommend a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

Decriminalizes various currently prohibited drugs, heroin, methamphetamine, ecstasy, LSD and psilocybin for all ages. Sets up Assessment Centers that can refer addicts to treatment facilities but would remove any requirement for addicts to attend these facilities. Funded by money currently being spent on K-12 schools.

OFC COMMENTARY

Measure 110 does the exact opposite of what its ballot title purports. It will increase dependency on hardcore drugs by decriminalizing them, while at the same time make drug treatment less available by defunding these services. Measure 110's primary effect would be the decriminalization of user amounts of heroin, methamphetamine, ecstasy, LSD and psilocybin. This would apply to juveniles and adults alike. Decriminalization sends the message that these drugs are not really all that bad or dangerous. The measure also decouples hardcore drug offenses from the justice system. Currently this system provides strong incentives to enter drug addiction treatment facilities. Many addicts admit, had they not been arrested and ordered to a treatment center, they would have died from their addiction. Measure 110 removes justice system incentives to enter residential treatment centers. Making matters worse, the measure removes money from treatment services. This exposes the deceptiveness of Measure 110's title. Finally, Measure 110 is financed in part by removing \$70 million from our K-12 schools. The consequences of decriminalizing hardcore drugs will lead to more drug use, not less. It additionally leads to more addicts and more people living on our streets with less services to help them. We urge a NO vote on Measure 110.

METRO M. 26-218

Infrastructure and Transportation Tax.

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

NO We recommend a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

Authorizes the Metro Council to impose a payroll tax up to 0.75% on companies with more than 25 employees but not on local governments. Directly raises about five billion dollars to be spent on transit and other transportation improvements. About half would be spent on a new light rail line from Portland to Bridgeport Village in Tigard.

OFC COMMENTARY

Over the last 3 elections, Metro has raised \$3.6 billion in taxes. This measure would raise twice that amount in one fell swoop. The new wage tax would directly raise about five billion dollars. The measure also anticipates raising another two billion from federal and state sources, for a total cost to taxpayers of seven billion dollars. This is the latest in a whole series of new taxes enacted recently, including the massive state gross receipts tax and Metro's recent parks and nature tax. We believe it is close to immoral to continue to pile up burdens on the backs of businesses and workers trying to survive a once in a lifetime crisis. The Portland Business Alliance pleaded with the Metro Council to reconsider placing this on the ballot, citing similar concerns. While Metro ignored business worries, the drafters exempted state and local governments from paying the tax citing "the pandemic's economic effects on government". Such hypocrisy is breath-taking. Half of the taxes collected will fund light rail from Portland to Bridgeport Village at a cost of \$250 million per mile. Consider the significant social changes the pandemic is creating. More people are moving away from congested cities, working from home, and shopping online. This light rail may be unnecessary. We recommend a NO vote on Measure 26-218.

MULTNOMAH 26-214

Tuition-Free Preschool Program.

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

NO We recommend a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

Creates tuition-free universal preschool for children 3 and 4 years of age throughout Multnomah County. The measure provides a variety of options including year-round preschool and aftercare. The program will be funded by levying an income tax of up to 3.8% on the County's higher earners and is estimated to raise \$123 million dollars.

OFC COMMENTARY

On its surface, many might view early learning to children as a benefit. Before jumping on the bandwagon, consider a couple factors. First, there are a variety of credible studies demonstrating that preschool programs such as Head Start have resulted in little or no educational success. Some point out increased behavior problems. The Obama administration released the "Head Start Impact Study" which found little to no impact on young children in the program. A second factor, which should especially concern people of faith, is what these impressionable young minds will be taught. Oregon's education elite seem to be promoting a progressive political philosophy alongside the fundamentals of reading, writing and arithmetic. The Director of the Oregon Department of Education is now recommending a curriculum that totally rewrites America's history. Adding to our concerns is ever-increasing taxes on higher earners. Oregon's top income tax rate already leads the nation. Measure 26-214 increases the rate on the highest earners an additional 25%. This measure will drive even more high earners out of the county. Meanwhile, 26-214 is in essence free childcare, thus drawing more users. The result will be a budget for free preschool that will increase, while taxpayers available to fund the program will likely decrease. We recommend a NO vote on Measure 26-214.

PORTLAND M. 26-217

Charter Change: Authorization of New Police Accountability and Oversight System

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

NO We urge a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

Replaces the current *Office of Independent Police Review* with *Police Accountability and Oversight System* which will hold substantial new powers. Creates a budget at 5% of the Portland Police Bureau's budget. Grants sweeping powers to compel police cooperation and testimony which could violate a police officer's constitutional rights and protections.

OFC COMMENTARY

Romans 13 makes clear that the most fundamental function of rulers is to protect the physical safety and property of citizens. To accomplish this, the government must have the power to restrain those who would attack these things. That we have a crisis in this area in Portland has become obvious in the past few months. To us this crisis exists because of the disempowerment of the police and our criminal justice system. Measure 26-217 makes this problem worse, not better. For instance, Measure 26-217 assumes the blame belongs to the police rather than those who are likely participating in criminal activity. By villainizing those defending the safety and property of law-abiding citizens, the citizens ultimately bear the consequences. Our first and most substantial objection to 26-217 is its drafters' false narrative of widespread police misconduct and racism. It is obvious that those who are given the weighty responsibility of using force against citizens must be held responsible for any abuse of that authority. Police are surely not above the law. However, neither are they below it which 26-217 seems to overlook. To accomplish lawful responsibility, Portland currently has an Office of Independent Police Review. Rather than improving that Office, 26-217 dissolves it, replacing it with a Police Accountability and Oversight System. It appears this measure is an attempt to placate the lawless by striking out at those who are trying to protect us: the police. Virtually no public input was obtained. The process was devoid of necessary transparency. The problems with 26-217 are too numerous to delineate. The all-powerful new Board remains murky in composition. It has no direct accountability even though it will have a great deal of funding out of the police budget. Furthermore, police privacy rights are trashed, as is their ability to avail themselves of due process for supposed criminal violations. If passed, Measure 26-217 would not solve Portland's problems but rather make matters much worse, further reducing Portland's effectiveness in protecting its citizens and their property. We urge a NO vote on Portland Measure 26-217.

COOS MEASURE 6-181

Second Amendment Sanctuary Ordinance

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

YES We urge a "Yes" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

Many attempts are being made in Oregon to restrict one's Second Amendment right to keep and bear arms. This measure will provide a buffer for Coos County citizens if some of these efforts find success at a state level.

OFC COMMENTARY

This measure would give Coos County officials the ability to protect county residents whose right to keep and bear arms is threatened by any other government official. It would let county officials stand between the citizen and whatever government entity is trying to remove the citizen's Second Amendment rights. Legally, this is known as "interposition." This practice has had a long history in western civilization. Consider Magna Carta, when in 1215, English barons compelled King John to agree to a "Great Charter." This contained a series of church rights and individual liberties. Its laws, processes, and procedures became foundational for our own laws and liberty. It could be said that the entire history of the growth of Western individual liberties was the result of such interventions. As Oregon has become increasingly progressive, bills and measures that would diminish Second Amendment rights are abounding. And if the Democrat candidate wins the presidency, we can expect the same sorts of attacks from the federal government. Given the current state of Oregon politics, this may be the most important ballot measure in 2020. Its significance goes far beyond the gun issue. We strongly recommend a YES vote. We also recommend that you and your friends become familiar with "interposition" for the protection of ALL our liberties.

DESCHUTES M. 9-134

Concerning ADDITIONAL Commercial Marijuana Businesses

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

NO We suggest a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

A "no" vote continues to prohibit additional commercial marijuana producers, processors, and processing sites in the unincorporated county. A "yes" vote overturns those ordinances and allows additional commercial marijuana producers, processors, and processing sites to continue to be established.

OFC COMMENTARY

Recreational use of marijuana is now legal in Oregon, but counties still have the authority to limit the number of production and processing sites. Deschutes County Commissioners have made use of that authority. This measure seeks to overturn the Commissioners and open up the county to unlimited production and processing of marijuana. Since marijuana is now a legal crop in Oregon, one could argue that this measure is promoting normal free market competition. But in the case of drugs such as marijuana, other factors come into the decision-making. This is why the state wisely chose to allow counties to impose various restrictions on this newly legalized intoxicant. Earlier this year, Deschutes County Commissioners tried to restrict production and processing facilities from property adjacent to places of substantial youth activity. But Oregon's Land Use Board (LUB) has overturned some of these particular decisions. The LUB cited procedural concerns about the county's definition of conditions that would trigger a denial of a permit to process. But the LUB did not disagree that such facilities should be located away from areas of youth activity. As the County Commissioners study the impacts of these marijuana facilities on the environment and community, we agree with their current practice of stopping further marijuana production and processing businesses until more work is done. We recommend a NO vote on this measure, leaving the county's moratorium intact.

MULTNOMAH M. 26-211

Library Funding

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

NO We recommend a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

If approved, this measure would authorize up to \$387,000,000 of general obligation bonds increasing property taxes. Money would be used to finance capital costs to increase the size and update library facilities across the county. This would include enlarging and modernizing eight county libraries and building a new flagship library.

OFC COMMENTARY

We are shocked that Multnomah County Commissioners would put this library measure before the voters at this time. Economic insecurity is the norm, not the exception. There seems to be little hope of reversing the economic woes created by the pandemic until well into next year at the earliest. A new flagship library. Nearly \$400 million in new taxes. Gigabit speed internet in all libraries. 2020 has been marked by severe economic misery for a large number of Oregonians, but public officials seem to have an insatiable appetite for more money. Something to consider is that technology has moved most users of books to digital distribution. There's still a place for libraries, but the footprint should become smaller, not larger. Also, libraries used to be a safe place for children and a place for learning. Now the Multnomah County Library System hosts events like Drag Queen Story Hour for kids. During this economically difficult season, it's time to hit pause on new taxes and fees no matter how worthy the cause. We recommend a NO vote on this measure.

PORTLAND M. 26-213

Recreation and Parks Levy

★ OFC RECOMMENDATION

LEAN NO We suggest a "No" vote.

OFC EXPLANATION

A measure directing a five-year local option property tax levy within the City of Portland for parks and recreation purposes at a rate of \$0.80 per \$1,000 of assessed value, commencing in fiscal year 2021-2022. Most homeowners would see property taxes increase more than 3 percent.

OFC COMMENTARY

The 2020 budget for Portland Parks and Recreation (PPR) is \$253.8 million. It is currently funded through various revenue streams like fees charged for events and activities, but its primary source is through existing property taxes. The cost per citizen for Portland's parks is nearly three times the expenditure of the nation's 100 largest cities' cost per citizen. Measure 26-213 adds some \$240 million over five years which is a 20% increase during an economic crisis. We are not alone in being concerned about Measure 26-213. During the meeting that sent this measure to the ballot, one city council member walked out of the meeting voicing strong concerns as she left. COVID-19 has been cited as a primary need for this tax. Certainly, the PPR budget has been impacted since that budget relies in part on fees for events that couldn't happen this summer. But the city's citizens who are being asked to pony up \$240 million have also been significantly impacted. This new tax will not go away when the COVID crisis does. It will continue for five years. Citizens and businesses, when facing a financial crisis, are forced to examine expenses and adjust their budgets accordingly. City government feels the luxury of meeting their budget challenges by burdening its citizens with more taxes. We suggest a NO vote on this measure.

In Oregon, qualifying contributions are eligible for the Political Tax Credit for Oregon taxpayers as follows: For married couples, \$100 is the maximum tax credit in any one year. For individuals, the maximum credit is \$50. Most households can receive 100% of your gift back on your 2020 tax return. Your tax consultant can provide further details.
