While the majority of candidates responded to our questionnaire, some did not. For those candidates we have presented past voting records, endorsements, affiliations, or other information that we hope will give you a better understanding of their position on these issues.

- I. Life. Do you support or oppose a law in Oregon restricting abortion with exceptions only for rape, incest and the life of the mother?
- 2. **Abortion Funding.** Do you support or oppose the use of tax dollars for abortion?
- 3. **Tax Kicker**. Do you support or oppose the tax kicker law that returns over collected taxes to taxpayers?
- 4. **Small Business.** Do you support or oppose raising taxes on small businesses?
- 5. **School Choice**. Do you support or oppose expanding school choice for K-12 grade education?
- Local Control. Do you support or oppose Senate Bill 1583 which gives the state greater control over school hoards?
- 7. **Sports.** Do you support or oppose legislation blocking biological men from competing in women's sports?
- 8. **Liberty**. Do you support or oppose including religious exemptions in legislation to prevent restrictions of religious freedom in hiring and insurance mandates?

## BALLOT MEASURES

Welcome to the Oregon Family Council Voter's Guide Ballot Measure section. Here you'll find information on each of the statewide measures that will appear on your 2024 General Election ballot. We've also included an OFC recommendation on how to vote and a helpful commentary on each measure's strengths and weaknesses.

We hope this guide will be a valuable supplement to other information sources in deciding how to vote.

#### IT'S OKAY TO DISAGREE

Many of the ballot measures we are asked to vote on this year are very complex. We have done our best to provide sound reasoning for the positions we have taken.

And while we provide a recommendation on measures, the last thing we want is to imply that these positions are the only ones Christians should take. Differences are okay and to be expected, particularly when it comes to applying the principles of the Bible to complex public policy issues.

We implore you to be careful and prayerful about the use of this Voter's Guide, and we encourage you to utilize other information sources. Most importantly, we urge you to vote. Your vote makes a difference.

## MEASURE 115

**Amends Constitution:** Authorizes impeachment of statewide elected officials by Oregon Legislature with two-thirds vote by each House; establishes process.

#### **★ OFC RECOMMENDATION ★**

YES

We recommend a "Yes" vote.

**OFC EXPLANATION:** In Oregon, statewide elected officials can be removed with a recall vote by the people, but they cannot be impeached. This Constitutional Amendment establishes a procedure for the Legislature to impeach elected state executives.

**OFC COMMENTARY:** Every state but Oregon has an impeachment process similar to the one outlined in the US Constitution. Unlike the other 49 states, removal of statewide elected officers in Oregon (Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Attorney General, and Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries) can only be accomplished through a recall. That process is expensive, labor-intensive, and it ultimately results in what could be characterized as a popularity contest. Measure  $115\ \mbox{would}$  bring Oregon an impeachment process with the biblical characteristics of justice that exists at our federal level. These include specific charges, witnesses, a trial in the Oregon State Senate overseen by a State Supreme Court Justice, a deliberative process, and a two-thirds majority vote in both House and Senate in order for an official to be removed from office. While the voters still hold these individuals accountable at the ballot box during elections, adding a way to impeach statewide candidates provides an extra measure of accountability. We recommend a YES vote on Measure 115.

**Amends Constitution:** Establishes "Independent Public Service Compensation Commission" to determine salaries for specified officials; eliminates legislative authority to set such salaries

**MEASURE 116** 

#### **★ OFC RECOMMENDATION ★**

LEAN NO

We lean toward a "No" vote.

**OFC EXPLANATION:** Currently, the Legislature sets and approves its own salaries. This Constitutional Amendment would create a new commission of unelected individuals to determine the wages our public servants are paid.

OFC COMMENTARY: It is the primary job of the Oregon Legislature to appove the use of all tax dollars. This measure would allow them to avoid responsibility in this area by changing our Constitution and setting up an independent commission to unilaterally declare the salaries of various state officials. The unelected and unaccountable commission would likely increase salaries significantly, spending millions of our tax dollars. Currently, salaries are set by passing a bill. That bill goes through the normal procedure which includes public hearings with input from citizens and experts. Legislators must choose how to vote, and the Governor can veto and approve the new salaries. Because these officials work for the people, they will be held accountable by the citizens at the next election for the decisions they make. Additionally, many of the specific details of this commission, including its composition, who will appoint them, and how much its members will be paid, are not included in Measure 116. As a result, these will have to be fleshed out in administrative rules. Our elected legislators need to start a big discussion about compensation, but this ballot measure sidesteps that for a process not accountable to the people. While the goal may be sound, the process is flawed. We recommend a NO vote on Measure 116

MEASURE 117

#### **★ OFC RECOMMENDATION ★**



We strongly urge a "No" vote

**OFC EXPLANATION:** Measure 117 establishes ranked-choice voting (RCV) for federal and statewide offices, eliminating party primaries for these races. Voters can rank candidates in order of preference instead of only voting for one candidate in each race.

OFC COMMENTARY: A handful of states have adopted RCV in the past few years, RCV centralizes voting procedures in the state rather than in county election offices. This loss of local control leads to increasing the risk of voter fraud and manipulation of the complicated RCV process. RCV results in greatly reduced transparency and a diminishment of trust in the process of elections. It's no wonder that RCV results in lower voter turnout. But what is it? That's complicated and that's part of the problem. One state that initiated it had to send out a 19-page manual to voters explaining it. At its most basic level RCV means you rank your choices of candidates in order of your preference. If no one gets fifty percent, the complicated computer process of throwing out some ballots and recategorizing the totals begins. The process then goes on and on until someone gets fifty percent of the remaining ballots. The loss of transparency, trustworthiness, and simplicity, and the movement from local control to state control makes RCV a bad choice. In addition, it is expensive. New equipment and software would drive costs substantially higher. No wonder that most of the states that adopted RCV are now moving to repeal it. We urge a NO vote on Measure 117.

## MEASURE 118

Increases highest corporate minimum taxes; distributes revenue to eligible individuals; state replaces reduced federal benefits.

#### **★ OFC RECOMMENDATION ★**

NO

We strongly recommend a "No" vote.

**OFC EXPLANATION:** This measure increases business gross receipt taxes to fund payments to all Oregon residents, including non-citizens.

**OFC COMMENTARY:** The first part of Measure 118 is the provision of an approximately \$1600 annual check to all Oregon residents. The second part involves the funding mechanism to pay for it which is essentially a sales tax on all business transactions. It is not a tax on profits but on the simple transaction itself. This establishes what some refer to as a UBI (universal basic income). This is the dream of all socialists and statists: dependence on civil government rather than the results of our labor. It is a de-motivator to work. However, according to Genesis 1 and 2, we are created to work and enjoy the blessings of our labor - both material and relational. In 2 Thes. 3:10, Scripture tells us that if a man won't work, neither should he eat. Proverbs reveals that hunger is God's gracious message to the slothful that he needs to work. The funding for this is also very harmful. It would ramp up yet more inflation. Businesses either pass on costs or they go out of business. By the time you buy a loaf of bread, this ballot measure would tax that bread multiple times, such as fuel for equipment and transportation, electricity, equipment purchases and leases, equipment maintenance, seed purchases, packaging, etc. Measure 118 attacks production and increases consumption which is the classic route to inflation. It is also important to consider that drug addicts would likely use the extra money to buy more drugs. We recommend a NO vote.

Cannabis retailers/processors must remain neutral regarding communications to their employees from labor organizations; penalties.

#### **★ OFC RECOMMENDATION ★**

**MEASURE 119** 



We recommend a "No" vote.

**OFC EXPLANATION:** Silences cannabis business managers and merchants during the employee union organizing process.

**OFC COMMENTARY:** Cannabis workers currently have all the same abilities to organize and unionize as other workers around the state. They have the same protections against intimidation or retaliation by their employers, and they have the same safety protections as other workers in Oregon. This measure seeks to give special privileges to cannabis workers not enjoyed by other industries. As cannabis workers investigate unionizing, this measure would require management to not engage in any conversation with their employees about the pros and cons of unionization. The only conversations allowed would be between the union organizers and the employees. The employers would be locked out of the dialogue. Scripture repeatedly commands dialogue as a means of reconciliation or coming to a joint conclusion. Our Constitution establishes freedom of speech which this measure seems to be violating. It certainly is violating the principle of dialogue by locking out the employers - one of the two parties in the business negotiations. Also of note, this measure is strongly supported by two groups of people: Democrat party officials and unions. One other aspect of this measure to consider is its effect on illegal cannabis. There is currently a serious problem in Oregon with illegal cannabis growers. This involves gangs, illegal weapons, and human trafficking. The effects of easy unionization would be increased labor costs which would then be passed on, resulting in higher cannabis costs. The higher the cost of legal cannabis, the more people turn to illegal sources. That is not good for Oregon. We recommend a NO vote on Measure 119.


